## TEMPORARY SIGNS

**"TEMPORARY SIGN"**: Any sign permitted for a limited period of time which is designed to be portable and can be moved by external means (e.g. **banners**, "**A-frames**", portable signs, air inflated balloons, flags with logo). Motorized, self-propelled, fully operable, licensed vehicles on which a sign is painted or securely attached shall not be considered signs.

(D) Temporary Signs in Commercial and Office Districts (B-2, B-1, O) and in Manufacturing Districts (M-3, M-2, M-1).

- (1) The Building Inspector may issue a sign permit for a maximum of 30 days for temporary signs. Temporary signs shall meet all height, size, and setback requirements applicable to permanent signs, but may be used to exceed the maximum allowable message area for a parcel or individual occupant.
- (2) On parcels with individual occupancy, a maximum of one (1) temporary sign shall be permitted. On parcels with multiple-occupant shopping centers, a maximum of three (3) temporary signs shall be permitted at any one time; however, no more than one (1) freestanding temporary sign may be located on any one (1) parcel at any time.
- (3) There must be at least an 180-day lapse between the issuance of temporary sign permits to any applicant.

Signs can not be placed in any public right-of-way or on public lands, including signs attached to trees, utility poles, public benches, or street lights.

(C) Sign **permits** for temporary signs **shall bear a fee** of \$10 plus a \$50 deposit refundable if the sign is removed within five (5) days of the expiration date of the permit. Any applicant not removing a sign within this time period shall forfeit the deposit and the temporary sign shall become an unlawful sign. **Permits issued** for temporary signs shall be for a **maximum of 30 days**, excepting permits for temporary signs already in place at the time of the permit application, for which the permit shall be for a time period of **15 days only**.
