### E. Dixie Drive in West Carrollton to be Closed for Demolition of Woody's Restaurant

The Contractor performing the demolition of the Woody's building has notified the City that E. Dixie Drive in the City of West Carrollton will be closed beginning Wednesday, April 11, 2007 to ALL traffic in the first block east of Alex-Bell Road. The closing will be for approximately five days while the over-the-road restaurant is demolished.

During the closing, detour routes will be set up, however, the City of West Carrollton Service Director, Rich Norton, advises motorists to avoid the area if possible. Norton says the nature of the street layout in the area will not allow the detour routes to flow without congestion.

Eastbound vehicle traffic on E. Dixie Drive will be detoured onto Alex-Bell Road to Springboro Pike (S.R. 741) to E. Dixie Drive.

E. Dixie Drive between Woody's and Crossover Street will be posted as two-way traffic for access to local business.

Westbound traffic on Alex-Bell Road will be detoured to Springboro Pike (S.R. 741) to E. Dixie Drive. Local traffic on Alex-Bell Road will continue to have access to businesses near Central Avenue and Bowman Lane.

Southbound I-75 highway traffic using Exit Ramp 47 for access to E. Dixie Drive will be detoured to use Crossover Street near the old Roberds facility.

Vehicles utilizing northbound I-75 will be detoured to Springboro Pike (S.R. 741) and may continue along Springboro Pike to Exit Ramp 50 or may utilize westbound Central Avenue to Crossover Street to E. Dixie Drive to Exit Ramp 47.

Again, motorists are encouraged to drive slower in the detour areas and allow extra time for the possible delays during the demolition of the over-the-road restaurant.
