A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING MAY 6, 2006, AND OCTOBER 7, 2006, AS "GARAGE SALE SATURDAYS" IN WEST CARROLLTON.

Whereas, many residents like to hold garage sales to dispose of various items, and

WHEREAS, garage sales benefit both the seller and buyer, and

WHEREAS, the city is limiting the number of days per year a resident can hold a garage sale to a maximum of six, and

WHEREAS, designating community garage sale days has proven worthwhile in other cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, STATE OF OHIO, HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1: That May 6, 2006, and October 7, 2006, are hereby designated as "Garage Sale Saturdays" in the City of West Carrollton. All residents wishing to hold garage sales are encouraged to do so on these dates.

Section 2: That the city shall actively promote the "Garage Sale Saturdays" in the news media in order to assist those residents holding garage sales.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage, the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 1: That the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids for the following vehicles:

Section 3: That the City Manager and Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidders therefore, and to expend a sum in excess of \$25,000 thereon, upon the approval of said bid by the City Manager.
