

SPECIAL JOINT MEETING
WEST CARROLLTON CITY COUNCIL AND MIAMI TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES

The meeting was held at the Miami Township Government Center at 2700 Lyons Road.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Self introductions were made. It's noted that all members of the West Carrollton City Council were present except Mayor Gilman who was excused from this meeting. In addition, West Carrollton staff members included Police Chief Rick Barnhart, Fire Chief Jack Keister, Service Director Richard Norton, and City Manager Tracy Williams. Also present were the Miami Township Trustees and Department Directors.

DISCUSSION

City Manager Tracy Williams and city officials gave an update on various activities that are occurring within the City of West Carrollton and reported on various progress that is being made with regards to economic development and other developments occurring within the city including the city's new comprehensive plan. Following this report the township officials gave a report on various developments that are occurring within Miami Township. It was noted by both jurisdictions that great progress is being made in the development of their communities and that generally there appears to be an upswing in development within the area.

Discussion was held concerning the current study underway concerning the possible implementation of a county wide dispatch system for public safety personnel.

Further discussion was held by those present on a variety of topics. Miami Township Administrator, Greg Hanahan, talked about how the Township had purchased a number of properties especially in conjunction with the anticipated new interchange at I-75 and Austin Road. Discussion was held concerning area bikeways and other matters of mutual interest to both communities.
