RESOLUTION 13-2020

A Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into a Community Residential Rehabilitation Loan Program Agreement and Open-End Mortgage with the Montgomery County Land Reutilization Corporation (Montgomery County Land Bank) for the Renovation of 323 East Central Avenue.

Mr. Lucking informed this resolution will allow the city manager to enter into an agreement for a \$50,000 loan to renovate 323 East Central Avenue otherwise known as the West Carrollton Historical Society home. This is a 0% interest loan and is open term in that it is a no defined repayment period. The expectation is that once the house is sold the proceeds will be distributed and the loan paid in full. We have a \$105,000 budget for the renovation and sources for that money are the \$50,000 loan that council would be considering tonight as well as a \$55,000 in sales proceeds from the Greenport property that we renovated several years ago. The intent is for an interior as well as exterior renovation including a new roof, siding, sidewalks, garage makeover, and a deck on the back. The interior will include making the kitchen flow and maintaining all of the woodwork. We really want to focus on the outside to bring it back to prominence as that block in the city is the postcard view of the city. We would like to start the project this year and I have plans developed that we can use to bid the project. Contractors are pretty busy right now so this project will probably start in the summer and finishes in the fall.

RESOLUTION 14-2020

A Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Advertise for Bids for the Construction of the North Elm Street Water Main Replacement Phase 1 Project and to Expend a Sum in Excess of \$50,000 Therefore.

Mr. Townsend informed due to the cuts to the CIP this year we have broken up the paving project into a couple of phases. Part of it will be done this year and part of it will be done next year. As part of this year's project we are going to replace the existing 4" water line with an 8" water line along North Elm Street between Main Street and Central Avenue that services those businesses. We did receive a \$40,000 grant from the county in the form of a block grant to pay for the design. The project is estimated at \$150,000 for Phase I and will be paid for out of the water fund.
