<u>Discussion on Uses of Federal ARPA Local Fiscal Recovery Funds</u>

Mr. Townsend presented council information on the American Rescue Plan Act federal funding allocation. West Carrollton is scheduled to receive between \$2.3 to \$2.5 million under the program. The first \$ 1.1million should be coming later this month.

Mr. Townsend recommended a series of proposals for uses of the funds, with priority on capital improvement projects and economic development programs. A copy of Mr. Townsend's presentation is available upon request from the office of the City Manager.
