<u>Resolution 36-2021</u> – A Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute a Real Estate Contract to Purchase 456 East Dixie Drive for a Purchase Price of One Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000.00).

Mr. Townsend presented Resolution 36-2021. He explained when we acquired the used car lot next to Baron's, we became aware this property was also available for purchase at a negotiated price of \$135,000.00, which is slightly below the market rate. He stated we agreed to that purchase price pending our due diligence, which has now been completed. He stated that we did not find anything toxic on the site, but the structure is in desperate need of demolition. Mr. Townsend advised our acquisition needs to take place no later than December 15th.

Mayor Sanner asked if there were any questions. There were none. Mayor Sanner asked if this fits in with our vision for the Downtown Corridor. Mr. Townsend answered yes.
