RESOLUTION 35-2019

A Resolution by the Council of the City of West Carrollton, Ohio Requesting the Auditor of Montgomery County to Certify the Total Current Tax Valuation of the City of West Carrollton, Entirely Located in Montgomery County, and the Dollar Amount of Revenue that Would be Generated by a 3.9 Mills Continuing Additional Levy Providing for the Salaries of Regular Full-Time and Part-Time Fire and Emergency Medical Personnel, Including the Payment of Any Employer Contributions Required Under the Ohio Revised Code, or Providing and Maintaining Fire Apparatus, Motor Vehicles, Communications, and Other Equipment Used Directly in the Operation of the Fire Department, or the Payments of Costs Incurred by the City as a Result of Contracts Made with Other Political Subdivisions in Order to Obtain Fire Protection as Authorized by Section 5705.19(I), of the Ohio Revised Code.

Mr. Townsend informed this Resolution is the first step in putting 3.9 mills levy for the benefit of the fire department on the March 17, 2020 ballet. This is to ask the auditors to certify the amount. We believe based on our current assessed valuation that this will generate approximately \$640,000 a year and the auditor will tell us for sure.
