

# RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

Resolution No. 18-2020 Passed July 28, 2020

*A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO PROVIDE FOR LIGHTING THE STREETS, LANES AND OTHER PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO WITH ELECTRIC LIGHTING DURING THE YEAR 2021 AND AUTHORIZING THE ASSESSMENTS FOR THE COST AND EXPENSE THEREOF UPON ALL LOTS AND LANDS LYING AND BEING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY.*

*WHEREAS, it is necessary that the streets, and other public ways of the City of West Carrollton, Ohio, be lighted with electric lighting during the year 2021, and a part of the cost and expense of said lighting be assessed by a percentage of the tax value of the property to be assessed.*

*NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of West Carrollton, Montgomery County, Ohio, that:*

SECTION 1: It is hereby declared necessary that the streets, lanes and other public ways of the City of West Carrollton, Ohio, described as follows, to wit: all of the streets, lanes and other public ways, with above ground utility poles abutting the streets, within the corporate limits City of West Carrollton, be lighted with electric lights during the year 2021.

SECTION 2: That 100% of the cost of said street lighting shall be levied assessed by a percentage of the tax value of all property in the City of West Carrollton, Ohio, which property is hereby declared and determined to be especially benefited thereby.

SECTION 3: That the assessment so to be levied on said benefited lands and lots shall be paid on one installment, in the manner provided for levying and collection of special assessments for street improvements.

SECTION 4: That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the tentative special assessments against specially benefited property as herein described, and the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution and filing of tentative assessments, in the manner prescribed by Section 727.14, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
