A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REALLOCATE FUNDS RECEIVED UNDER THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT.

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law on March 11, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the Act included payments to non-entitlement units of local government for revenue replacement due to the impact of the COVID 19 pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrollton will receive \$1,347,518 to replace revenue losses in the General Fund, as well as other funds, due to the continuing impact of the pandemic on the economy; and,

WHEREAS, the West Carrollton City Council is desirous of redirecting said funds to support Wilson Park pool, and various capital projects and economic development activities within the City of West Carrollton.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to reallocate funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), to support the priorities of the City Council as outlined on the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
