WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) has solicited local government entities to submit new water and wastewater projects for funding consideration; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrollton has committed to a timely project development schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrollton will commit the necessary resources to support the estimated local cost portion of the project, if required, and the following list will be submitted to ODOD, shown in order of the City of West Carrollton's priority:

1. Central Lane 8" Water Main Replacement

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That this Resolution shall serve to authorize the transmittal and submittal of applications for the following water and wastewater infrastructure projects to ODOD for funding consideration:

1. Central Lane 8" Water Main Replacement

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign on behalf of the City the application for funds as referred to in Section 1 of this Resolution.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to take or cause to be taken all other action necessary and proper to secure the funding sought by the application referred to herein, and provide any additional information sought by reviewing agencies during the time the application is under review. The City Manager is further directed and authorized to cause compliance will all reporting requirements required by the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) as required as part of the funding process.
