A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO REQUESTING THE AUDITOR OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, ENTIRELY LOCATED IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY AN 3.9 MILLS CONTINUING ADDITIONAL LEVY PROVIDING FOR THE SALARIES OF REGULAR FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF ANY EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS REQUIRED UNDER THE OHIO REVISED CODE, OR PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FIRE APPARATUS, MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, OR THE PAYMENTS OF COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY AS A RESULT OF CONTRACTS MADE WITH OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FIRE PROTECTION AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 5705.19(I), OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of West Carrollton, Ohio, entirely located in Montgomery County, hereby declares the necessity of a continuing additional tax levy in excess of the ten-mil limitation in the amount of 3.9 mills in accordance with O.R.C. 5705.03(B)(1); and

WHEREAS, O.R.C. 5705.03 (B)(1) requires the City to request the County Auditor to certify a total current tax valuation of the City of West Carrollton and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the specified number of mils.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, STATE OF OHIO, HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of West Carrollton, in accordance with O.R.C. 5705.03 (B), requests the Montgomery County Auditor to certify the current total tax valuation of the City of West Carrollton and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a 3.9 mills continuing additional levy.

SECTION 2: It is necessary that the additional tax be levied in excess of the ten-mil limitation for the purpose of Providing for the Salaries of Regular Full-Time and Part-Time Fire and Emergency Medical Personnel, Including the Payment of Any Employer Contributions Required Under the Ohio Revised Code, or Providing and Maintaining Fire Apparatus, Motor Vehicles, Communications, and Other Equipment Used Directly in the Operation of the Fire Department, or the Payments of Costs Incurred by the City as a Result of Contracts Made with Other Political Subdivisions in Order to Obtain Fire Protection as Authorized by Section 5705.19(I), of the Ohio Revised Code.

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SECTION 3: The question of passage of said continuing additional tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the City of West Carrollton at an election to be held on March 17, 2020. If a majority of the voters voting on this continuing additional levy vote in favor thereof, this levy shall be first placed on the tax list and duplicate for the tax year of 2020, for collection in calendar year 2021.

SECTION 4: Pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the County Auditor is hereby requested to certify to the City of West Carrollton the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the number of mills specified in Section 1 hereof, and the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Montgomery County Auditor immediately upon its adoption.

SECTION 5: That this Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage, the earliest period allowed by law.
