AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATIONS, RATES OF PAY, AND WORKING CONDITIONS FOR POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE WEST CARROLLTON POLICE ASSOCIATION (WCPA), REPRESENTING SAID EMPLOYEES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3662 AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, STATE OF OHIO, HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

- Section 1: The personnel classifications, rates of pay, and working conditions described in the attached agreement are hereby authorized and adopted.
- Section 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement on behalf of the City of West Carrollton with the West Carrollton Police Association, representing police officers in the West Carrollton, Ohio, Police Department. A copy of this agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance by reference.
- Section 3: Ordinance No. 3662, a copy of which is attached hereto, and any other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATIONS, RATES OF PAY, AND WORKING CONDITIONS FOR POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE WEST CARROLLTON POLICE ASSOCIATION (WCPA), REPRESENTING SAID EMPLOYEES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3625 AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, STATE OF OHIO, HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1: Personnel Classification, Rates of Pay, and Working Conditions - The personnel classifications, rates of pay, and working conditions described in the attached agreement are hereby authorized and adopted.

Section 2: Agreement Authorization - The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement on behalf of the City of West Carrollton with the West Carrollton Police Association, representing police officers in the West Carrollton, Ohio, Police Department. A copy of the agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance by reference.

Section 3: Previous Ordinances - Ordinance No. 3625, a copy of which is attached hereto, and any other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is necessary to provide adequate compensation for police officers of the City of West Carrollton and to approve terms of an agreement between the City of West Carrollton and the West Carrollton Police Association, effective December 25, 2019, and the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of West Carrollton, and therefore, this Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage, the earliest period allowed by law.
