A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL FAST ACT FUNDS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MIAMI CONSERVANCY DISTRICT (MCD) THROUGH THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION (MVRPC) FOR BIKE TRAIL SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT THE FARMERSVILLE - WEST CARROLLTON ROAD INTERSECTION.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to take or cause to be taken all other action necessary and proper to secure the funding sought by the application referred to herein, and provide any additional information sought by reviewing agencies during the time the application is under review. The City Manager is further directed and authorized to cause compliance will all reporting requirements required by the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) as required as part of the funding process.

<u>Section 4</u>: Upon application approval, the City hereby states its commitment to the local contribution for the project as identified in these applications, including local contribution of costs exceeding the current estimates or subsequent revised estimates as accepted by the MVRPC.
