except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance; provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the <i>City, and for purposes other than those covered by the specific appropriations herein made.</i> Section 4: The City Manager shall have the authority to implement such interfund transfers and advances as are identified and approved (from the budget presentation) by this appropriation ordinance, without further consent or approval of City Council. City Council has reviewed and approved expenditures within the General Fund by department and per O.R.C. 5705.38(C), the levels of budgetary control are appropriated accordingly within the budget presented and approved by City Council, prior to the adoption of the annual appropriation ordinance. Section 5: The City Manager shall have the authority to determine the usefulness of City property and may dispose of obsolete or surplus items at his or her discretion after public notification. Section 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency being the necessity of meeting the City's current obligations.
