Ordinance 3762 – An Ordinance To Make Appropriations For Current Expenses And Other Expenditures Of The City Of West Carrollton, State Of Ohio, During The Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2023, Amending Ordinance 3757, And Repealing Any Ordinances In Conflict Herewith.

Mrs. Duffy presented Ordinance 3762. She explained this ordinance will allow for the final adjustments needed to support city operations through December 31, 2023. One adjustment would allow for the transfer of monies from the General Fund to the Recreation Fund (210). A second adjustment involves funds in Parks (212), which is being utilized for the ongoing clean-up of the former Appvion WWTP. Finally, an additional appropriation is being requested for the Undivided Income Tax (802) fund to ensure that all received income tax funds through December 31, 2023 can be transferred to both the General Fund (100) and the One-Half % Income Tax fund (804). This ordinance was presented as a first reading. It will be on the next agenda.

Discussion on the Impact of the New Recreational Marijuana Law

Ms. Denlinger gave council a brief overview of the new recreational marijuana law, that will go into effect on December 7th. The law provides for recreation possession and use as well as directs the legislature to develop rules and regulations for sales. Those rules have not been written, so many municipalities are declaring moratoriums on issuing permits until the rules are established.

After a brief discussion, it was the consensus of council to place an emergency moratorium ordinance on the December 12th council agenda for consideration.
