SECTION 3: And the Finance Director is hereby authorized to draw his warrants for payment of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board of officers, authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance; provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the City, and for purposes other than those covered by the specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION 4: The City Manager shall have the authority to implement such interfund transfers and advances as are identified and approved (from both the budget presentation and this ordinance) by this appropriation ordinance, without further consent or approval of City Council. City Council has reviewed and approved expenditures within the General Fund by department and per O.R.C. 5705.38(C), the levels of budgetary control are appropriated accordingly within the budget presented and approved by City Council, prior to the adoption of the annual appropriation ordinance.

SECTION 5: The City Manager shall have the authority to determine the usefulness of City property and may dispose of obsolete or surplus items at his or her discretion after public notification.
