A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM APPLICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR CITY GATEWAY SIGNS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REPRESENT THE CITY IN FULFILLING ALL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, Montgomery County is currently soliciting applications for the FY24 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding cycle, with approximately \$800,000 available to communities including the City of West Carrollton whose CDBG funds are administered by the County; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the vision of the city's *Urban Design Plan* and *West Carrollton Sustainable Comprehensive Plan* to enhance the image, appearance, and economic value of the community and the quality of the built environment, the city has constructed five high-quality, attractive, and substantial stone gateway signs; and

WHEREAS, since twelve gateway signs which were installed prior to 2006 are deteriorating and in need of replacement, the City of West Carrollton desires to submit an application seeking grant funds from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program administered by Montgomery County for the construction of new stone city gateway signs to replace four of those signs; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrollton has the authority to apply for and to administer the amounts received from this program, and this project is believed to meet eligibility requirements for said funding by meeting at least one of the three National Objectives, specifically to principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons by enhancing the appearance and image of the community, promoting neighborhood identity and pride, and elevating economic value by creating a sense of place through unified design elements as part of a larger branding initiative; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of West Carrollton must direct and authorize the City Manager to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The City Manager, or her designee, be herewith authorized to act, and designated as the official representative of the City of West Carrollton, in conjunction with all aspects of the preparation, filing, provision of information, and submittal of documentation necessary for participation in the Federal CDBG application and funding process, administered by Montgomery County, Ohio, all such activities being necessary to secure funding for the construction of four city gateway signs.

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Section 2: The West Carrollton City Council hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

Section 3: The City Council hereby commits itself to provide the local share of the total project cost, as specified in the application.

Section 4: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this Resolution to be served as required by law.

Section 5: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
