A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A FY2025 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM APPLICATION TO REPLACE THE TWO CITY LOGO SIGNS AT EXIT 47, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REPRESENT THE CITY IN FULFILLING ALL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, Montgomery County is currently soliciting applications for the FY2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding cycle, with approximately \$800,000 available to communities including the City of West Carrollton whose CDBG funds are administered by the County; and

WHEREAS, it is understood from Montgomery County that while the FY2025 application process is proceeding, there is some uncertainty surrounding the new administration's federal budget and at this time Montgomery County is operating under a continuing resolution and is assuming that funding in 2025 will be consistent with the 2024 allocation; however, all CDBG funding—including current and future allocations—is subject to availability and may be impacted by federal-level changes; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrollton has the authority to apply for and to administer the amounts received from this program, and this project is believed to meet eligibility requirements for said funding by meeting at least one of the three National Objectives, specifically to principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons by enhancing the appearance and image of the community, promoting neighborhood identity and pride, and elevating economic value by creating a sense of place through unified design elements as part of a larger branding initiative; and

WHEREAS, an eligible activity for the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds is the construction, reconstruction or installation of infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrolton desires to submit an application seeking grant funds from the accelerated Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program administered by Montgomery County to replace the two city logo signs at Exit 47; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrollton has the authority to apply for and to administer the amounts received from this program, and this project meets all eligibility requirements for said funding; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of West Carrollton must direct and authorize the City Manager to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.
