PRESENTATION OF 2026 PROPOSED BUDGET

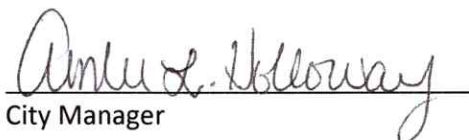
