

## RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

Resolution No. 7-2026

Passed: February 10, 2026

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF CITY VEHICLES AND TO EXPEND A SUM IN EXCESS OF \$79,568 THEREFORE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Carrollton's vehicle fleet has a useful lifespan; and

**WHEREAS**, two police vehicles utilized by the West Carrollton Police Department have met their useful lifespan; and

**WHEREAS**, the prompt replacement of these two police vehicles is necessary to facilitate efficient governmental operations and maintain public service; and

**WHEREAS**, the West Carrollton Police Department's maintenance of an adequate fleet of police vehicles helps protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens in the community; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 32.10 of the City of West Carrollton Code of Ordinances (the "WCO"), the City Manager, as the purchasing agent for the City, is authorized to make purchases for the City that do not exceed the statutory limit prescribed by Ohio Revised Code Section 9.17, which current statutory limit is \$79,568; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost to replace the listed vehicles is \$160,000, which exceeds the statutory threshold prescribed by Ohio Revised Code Section 9.17 and therefore, requires competitive bidding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO:**

**Section 1:** The City Manager or her designees are hereby authorized to advertise for bids and execute any and all documents, not in conflict herein, necessary for the purchase of two police cruisers for the West Carrollton Police Department Cruisers at an estimated cost of \$160,000.

**Section 2:** The City Manager or her designees are further authorized to advertise for bids either separately or in conjunction with other governmental agencies, or both, for the above listed vehicles in order to obtain the best bid possible for the City of West Carrollton.

**Section 3:** The City Manager and Finance Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder therefore, and to expend a sum in excess of \$79,568 thereon, upon the approval of said bid by the City Manager.

**Section 4:** Funds have been appropriated in the Vehicle Replacement Fund (Fund 412) or are in the process of collection in an amount sufficient to pay the purchase price for the two police vehicles described herein.

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**Section 5:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 6:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
