Resolution No. 9-2026

Passed: February 10, 2026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2026 STREET RESURFACING AND REPAIR PROGRAM AND TO EXPEND A SUM IN EXCESS OF \$79,568 THEREFORE.

WHEREAS, the City budgets funds to participate in an annual program to resurface and repair the City's roads, alleys, and public parking lots (the "Street Resurfacing and Repair Program"); and

WHEREAS, Fund 402 for Street Improvement has \$644,133 budgeted for the resurfacing and repair of the City's roads and \$60,000 budgeted for resurfacing and repair of the City's alleys and public parking lots in 2026; and

WHEREAS, a list of the City's roads, alleys, and public parking lots for the annual program is typically developed in the first quarter of the year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32.10 of the City of West Carrollton Code of Ordinances (the "WCO"), the City Manager, as the purchasing agent for the City, is authorized to make purchases for the City that do not exceed the statutory limit prescribed by Ohio Revised Code Section 9.17, which current statutory limit is \$79,568; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost to implement the 2026 Street Resurfacing and Repair Program exceeds the statutory threshold prescribed by Ohio Revised Code Section 9.17 and, therefore, requires competitive bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO:

Section 1: The City Manager or her designees are hereby authorized to advertise for bids and execute any and all documents, not in conflict herein, necessary for the implementation of the 2026 Street Resurfacing and Repair Program, which allows for the resurfacing and repair of the City's roads, alleys, and public parking lots.

Section 2: The City Manager or her designees are further authorized to advertise for bids either separately or in conjunction with other governmental agencies, or both, for the implementation of the 2026 Street Resurfacing and Repair Program in order to obtain the best bid possible for the City of West Carrollton.

Section 3: The City Manager and Finance Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder therefore, and to expend a sum in excess of \$79,568 thereon, upon the approval of said bid by the City Manager.

Section 4: Funds have been appropriated in the Street Improvement Fund (Fund 402), or are in the process of collection, in an amount sufficient to pay the estimated cost of the 2026 Street Repair and Resurfacing Program.

Section 5: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and

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that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
