

# RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

**A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE APPRECIATION OF THE CITIZENS AND PUBLIC OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON FOR SERVICES RENDERED UNTO SAID CITY BY MICHAEL A. HANKS.**

**WHEREAS**, Michael Hanks joined the West Carrollton Police Department as a Police Explorer at the age of sixteen (16), was appointed a Reserve Officer in March of 2000, was hired as a full-time Police Officer in September of 2000, and was promoted to the rank of Sergeant in July of 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, Michael Hanks throughout his career served the West Carrollton Police Department as a bike patrol officer, evidence technician, and crash reconstruction officer. In the role of sergeant, he oversaw the departments training, scheduling, bike patrol program, riot control team, and coordination of special events. Sergeants Hanks also served on the Regional Crowd Management Team; and

**WHEREAS**, Michael Hanks was recognized as the West Carrollton Police Department Employee of the Year in 2003, and has received numerous letters of commendation and appreciation; and

**WHEREAS**, Michael Hanks retired from the City of West Carrollton on March 9, 2026, after more than twenty-six (26) years of dedicated service.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO:**

**Section 1:** That the citizens and public officials of the City of West Carrollton express their grateful appreciation for the exemplary services rendered by Michael Hanks to said city.

**Section 2:** That a duly executed and inscribed copy of this Resolution shall be made a part of the official record of Ordinances and Resolutions of the Council of the City of West Carrollton so that this record of appreciation for the services of, Michael Hanks, shall thereby be preserved for posterity.
