

## RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

Resolution No. 28-2026

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A MONTGOMERY COUNTY ARTS & CULTURAL DISTRICT SPECIAL PROJECTS GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION, AS WELL AS ANY OTHER ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS OR INFORMATION REQUIRED, TO SEEK PARTIAL FUNDING FOR A PUBLIC MURAL AND TO REPRESENT THE CITY IN FULFILLING ANY OTHER ADDITIONAL GRANT PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Montgomery County Arts and Cultural District (“MCACD”) is a special purpose unit of government created under Ohio law to provide support to arts and cultural organizations and individual artists within Montgomery County, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, MCACD anticipates providing up to \$250,000 in the 2026-2027 Special Projects Grant Program (the “SPGP”) to support local arts, cultural, and heritage projects; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are distributed through the SPGP, on a competitive basis, to arts and cultural organizations as well as public agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wants to apply to the SPGP for partial funding for a public artistic mural within the City of West Carrollton.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That the City Manager or her designee is herewith authorized to prepare and submit a MCACD SPGP Application, as well any other additional documentation or information required, to seek partial funding for a public artistic mural in the City of West Carrollton.

**Section 2.** That the City Manager or her designee is further authorized to take any and all action necessary to represent the City in fulfilling any other additional SPGP requirements.

**Section 3.** That the West Carrollton City Council hereby acknowledges that participation in the Program will require compliance with SPGP guidelines and assurances.

**Section 4.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5.** That this Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage, the earliest period allowed by law.
