

RECORD OF RESOLUTIONS

Resolution No. 42-2026

Passed: September 8, 2026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE AND REPLACE EMERGENCY GENERATORS AT FIRE STATION 56 AND 57 AT A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$182,000.00.

WHEREAS, the City of West Carrollton's critical infrastructure includes emergency generators at Fire Station 56 and 57; and

WHEREAS, the City's current emergency generators have reached the end of their lifespan and performance is declining; and

WHEREAS, the prompt replacement of the emergency generators is in the best interest of the public, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 9.48 provides for the procedure whereby purchases may be made by political subdivisions without competitive bidding by participating in contracts awarded by Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing; and

WHEREAS the City's Parks Director recommends that the City move forward with the proposal of Buckeye Power Sales ("BPS") for two generators at a cost of \$128,142.00; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Director recommends that the City utilize Reliable Electric for the installation of the two generators at a cost of \$52,909.00, plus a small contingency amount if necessary, with the total cost of the two new generators and their installation not to exceed \$182,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Fund will be utilized to pay for the purchase of the emergency generators and their installation; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds it necessary, upon the recommendation of the City Manager and Parks Director, to authorize the purchase and installation of two emergency generators at Fire Stations 56 and 57.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST CARROLLTON, OHIO:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the City, two emergency generators from Buckeye Power Sales and to authorize Reliable Electric to install the two emergency generators for a total cost not to exceed one hundred eighty-two thousand dollars (\$182,000.00).

Section 2: Funds have been appropriated in the Fire Fund or are in the process of collection in an amount sufficient to pay the authorized purchase and installation price.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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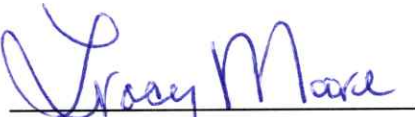
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Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
